The NSW RTA Camera Enforcement Branch (CEB) is responsible for the management and maintenance of cameras to detect offences at fixed speed, red-light, bus lane, T-Way and Safe-T-Cam (heavy vehicle offences) sites. The camera management program and other RTA CEB initiatives have been effective in contributing to the ongoing reduction of deaths and injuries caused by speeding vehicles on NSW roads.

For the RTA Camera Enforcement Branch to effectively meet increased volumes from the imminent rollout of the digital camera and red light program, Tenix Solutions was commissioned to review the back-office systems and processes used within the camera programs so as to enhance the preparation of briefs of evidence for Court.

Essential to the project was the ability for the RTA CEB management team to retain efficiency by aligning current processes to manage increased camera volumes. The project therefore focussed on a review of the current processes, an outcome of which was a series of recommendations that would assist in maintaining and increasing efficiency.
